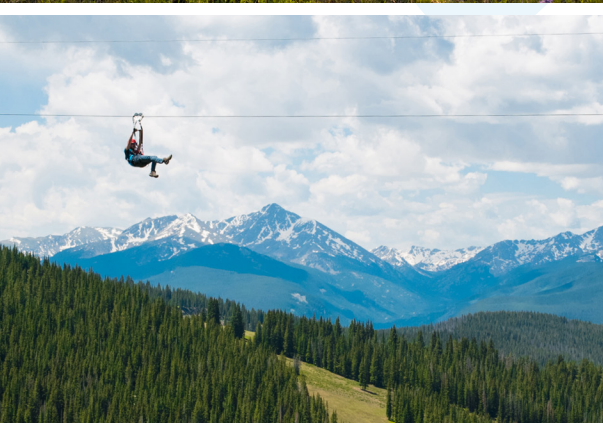
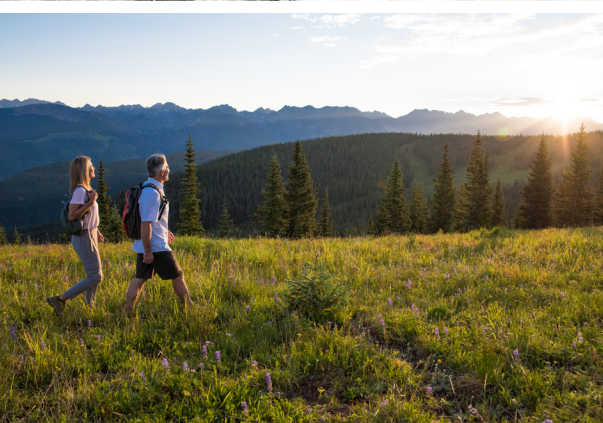

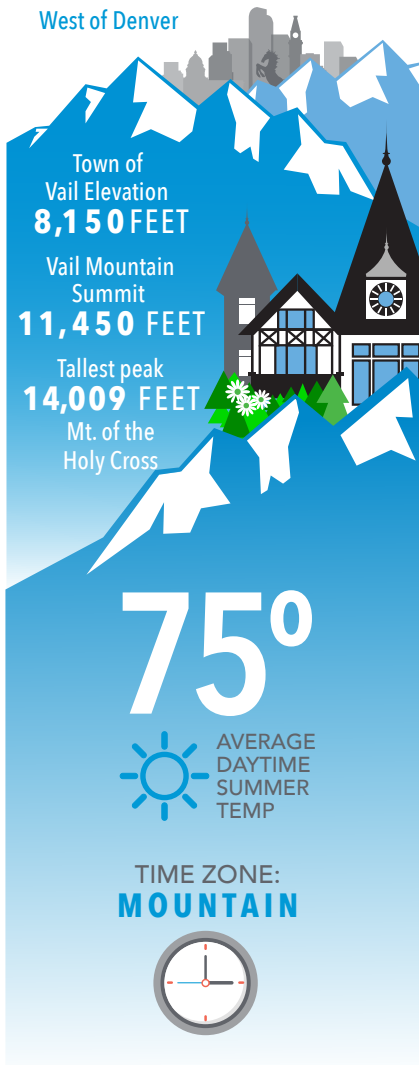

NEWS BITES



- › Hiking is the No. 1 activity enjoyed by summer visitors. There are more than 23 miles of paved recreational path in Vail and nearly 200 miles of hiking trails in Eagle County.
- › The Vail Jazz Festival is celebrating its 25th season with performances throughout the summer.
- › Renowned artist Patrick Dougherty's interactive installation Stickworks, built of locally harvested willow limbs, will be on display through 2019.
- › Steve Martin and Martin Short will perform musical sketches under the stars during this summer's Whistle Pig Vail music series.
- › The GoPro Mountain Games in June are the largest celebration of outdoor adventure sports in the country with more than 35 competitive events, including kayaking, mountain biking, rock climbing and more.
- › Vail is the first destination in the world to be certified to the Mountain *IDEAL* sustainable destination standard. Additionally, Vail's certification to the Global Sustainable Tourism Council's (GSTC) destination standard represents the first in the United States.
- › This summer the Chamber Orchestra Vienna - Berlin will mark its North American Debut at the Bravo! Vail music festival, joining the New York Philharmonic, The Philadelphia Orchestra and Dallas Symphony Orchestra.
- › Epic Discovery is Vail's summer on-mountain experience focusing on learning through play. The primary elements include the Game Creek Zipline Tour, Forest Flyer mountain coaster, ropes challenge courses, expanded interpretive trail system and more.
- › Vail enjoys nearly 300 days of sunshine a year with little to no humidity.
- › With three music festivals, a season long concert series and regular community performances, Vail offices live music nearly every night of the week in the summer.
- › With more than 343 miles of mountain bike trails in town and many more beyond, Vail is the perfect place to hop on a bike and checkout mother nature's roller coaster.
- › Piney River Ranch, located at the base of the Gore Range, offers glamping and cabin experiences on the banks of a picturesque mountain lake.
- › The Vail Dance Festival was formed when First Lady Betty Ford helped secure a performance by the renowned Bolshoi Ballet in Vail in 1989.
- › Each playground in Vail has a signature piece of interactive art created by various artists. Sunbird Park in Lionshead was named one of the World's Coolest Playgrounds.
- › Bravo! Vail will debut Puccini's wildly popular opera, Tosca, with an all-star international cast, two choruses and the artistry of The Philadelphia Orchestra under the stars at the Gerald R. Ford Amphitheater.

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
